

KPI 1: Retention Rates

Retention rates represent the percentage of a school's full-time, first-time undergraduate students who are enrolled in the Fall and continue at that college the next Fall term. Retention rates are directly related to the Strategic Plan 2025 Priority #1: Academic Excellence. Students who are retained are more likely to complete the required coursework to earn a credential or degree.

EMCC will retain FFTT students. This rate is compared to state and national rates, and identified within the parameter of institutional performance range.
